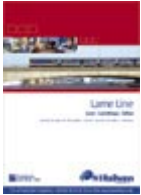

Metro Fares

There are three main cash fares for travelling on the Metro:

From Monday 31st March 2008

- £1.10 for travel within the Inner Zone (Child £0.55)
- £1.40 for travel in the City Zone and City Zone/Inner Zone (Child £0.70)
- £1.70 for travel beyond the City Zone (Child £0.85)

Metro Day Tickets also available >>

Corridor 2 - Shore Road

- Inner Zone fares extend to York rd (St Paul's).
- City Zone Fares extend to Antrim Rd/Bellevue, Church Rd/Courthouse, Merville.
- Extended Zone Fares extend Glenville Rd, Monkstown Estate.

It pays to have a metro day - pick up your metro day ticket from the driver.

£3.50

anywhere, anytime on the Metro network, any
one day, Monday to Saturday.

£2.50*

anywhere on the Metro network after
10am, Monday to Saturday or all day
Sunday

These are adult fares - child fares are half of the above. Metro day ticket fares are valid for travel on the day of purchase only.

Metro Nightlink

Nightlink is a convenient, cost effective and reliable late night service 'home' from Belfast city centre after a Saturday night (01:00 hrs & 02:00 hrs). There are eight Nightlink services – only 2 go towards University of Ulster's Jordanstown campus:
